Job Objective

The major goal of the position is to perform housekeeping cleaning tasks in order to achieve Company's standards of cleanliness.

Responsibilities

- 10. Properly handling and maintenance of all equipment necessary for his/her working tasks.
- 11. Maintains a safe and sanitary environment for guests and fellow employees.
- 12. Knowledgeably answers questions about ship's schedules, travel routes, and ship's services when asked by Guests during the course of performing his duties in public areas, displaying courtesy every time he/she is in contact with a Guest.
- 13. Must assist with the handing of Guest's luggage on embarkation and disembarkation days.
- 14. Ensures personal appearance, personal hygiene and uniforms appearance is at all times in accordance with Company Policy.
